QUALIFICATIONS:

CORRECTIONAL OFFICER:

- At least 18 years of age
- US Citizen or meet standards of US Naturalization and Immigration Service for employment
- No felony convictions
- No misdemeanor convictions for domestic violence offenses
- Able to qualify with and carry firearms
- Not a candidate for or hold a political office
- Must pass written exam, drug test, and physical exam
- Males 18-25 yrs old must be registered with Selective Service
- Possess a valid Louisiana driver's license
- Must successfully complete the training required by the Department

PROBATION AND PAROLE OFFICER

- Baccalaureate degree or equivalent experience
- Willingness and ability to carry firearms
- Willingness and ability to obtain P.O.S.T certification
- Pass a drug test
- Possess a valid Louisiana driver's license
- Pass a physical examination & psychological test
- Acceptable score on Civil Service Exam
- No Felony convictions

P.O.S.T. Certification: refers to Peace Officer Standards Training. It is required because P&P Officers are commissioned law officers. They must be skilled and trained to carry firearms

EMPLOYEE BENEFITS

- Annual Merit increases commensurate with Civil Service Rules and Regulations
- Employer contributes approximately 60% of cost of pension plan
- Employer pays 50% of group life insurance
- Employer pays approximately half the cost of group health insurance
- Paid military leave up to 15 days per year
- Vacation pay starts at 12 days per year for the first year and increases to 21 days per year after 10 years
- Sick leave starts at 12 days per year
- 8-12 paid holidays per year
- 25 year retirement with 3-1/3% accrual rate for each year of service.
- Eligible for membership in DOC credit union
- Correctional Officer uniforms and equipment furnished by employer
- Overtime after 86 hours in a pay period will be compensated at time and one-half pay or compensated with time off for Correctional Officers
- Probation and Parole Applicants who possess a Masters Degree are eligible to be hired 10% above the minimum entry rate.
